1. Apologies for Absence

3. Planning Applications – Land off old A65 24/2016/17616

At the invitation of the Vice-Chairman, Mr Ellis (Rural Solutions), representing the developer, presented details of the proposed outline planning application for a development of 9 houses on land off the old A65.

Questions were taken from the floor, and comments were made relating to the location of the development site outside the village boundary, and its scale, relative to the size of the core settlement of Draughton village. Residents raised issues concerning the safety aspects of the increased traffic and parking which would result from the development, and with the capacity of the local infrastructure to service the additional households at the top of the village.

Mr Ellis and two members of the public left the meeting.

After full discussion, and taking account of the comments and concerns raised by members of the public, it was then unanimously

RESOLVED (Proposed: the Vice-Chairman; seconded: Cllr Plunkett): "THAT an objection be made to the proposed outline planning application for a development of 9 houses on land off the access road into Draughton (Ref 24/2016/17616) for reasons concerning its location, outside the village boundary and in an unsustainable development area with no facilities or amenities, and its scale, relative to the size of the core settlement area of the village, and in respect of other material considerations, including traffic concerns, and its impact on the residential amenity of neighbouring properties, and that the Clerk be authorised to submit a letter of comments to the planning authority accordingly."
