Notes on the Walks

All walks start at St Augustine's Church Draughton (Grid reference SE 0390), Where there is parking. Care has been taken to try to make sure that the information is accurate, but rights of way may change from time to time. No liability can be accepted for any inaccuracies. Timings assume an



overall speed of two miles per hour, which is average walking speed allowing for some short stops. Most walks are not strenuous although there are some hills. Walks intersect, so they can be adapted for personal taste or requirements. The sheet for each walk is self-contained. The start point is at 192 metres above mean sea level (AOD). The following abbreviations may be used: GR = Grid reference, km = kilometres, M = miles, m = metres, AOD = above Ordnance datum.

Maps

Maps and Apps suitable for walkers are available from shops or from the Ordnance Survey at <u>www.ordnancesurvey.co.uk</u>.

Footwear and Clothing

Stout shoes and clothing suitable for the conditions are strongly recommended at all times, and especially for the suggested extensions to Embsay Crag and Eastby Gate (Walk 2) and for Walk 7.

Food and Drink

Where opening times of food and drink outlets are mentioned, they are the normal times published at the time this guide was written and may change at any time.

Dogs

Please keep a dog on its lead at all times in areas used by livestock *except* if being stampeded by cattle, when it is safer to leave it to make its own escape until the danger is past.

Please also clear up your dog's faeces, bag it, and take it home.

Farm Gates

Please do not climb over farm gates. If you have to open a gate, please make sure it is closed securely afterwards. Do not cross fields that are not rights of way.

Country Code

Please follow the Country Code at all times.
