A LAND USE FRAMEWORK FOR ENGLAND

We write as organisations with a strong interest in ensuring that the finite and precious land in England is used effectively. Following the publication of the House of Lords Land Use in England Committee Inquiry report we want to highlight the attributes the government framework must have if it is to ensure land is used to deliver better public value. These are:

- The Land Use Framework for England must be owned and delivered across government, covering all major land use changes, not just agricultural, to tackle siloed and sub-optimal approaches.
- It must optimise the multifunctional use of land so that economic, environmental and social targets are met in ways that deliver real public value.
- The Framework must facilitate effective use and integration of data to enable better decisions, by making available existing data at national, regional and local level.
- The Framework must be neither top down nor bottom up alone, but must facilitate genuine community, business and civil society involvement in the ways that national targets are met at the local and regional levels.

A Land Use Framework for England could be an essential tool to facilitate innovation, economic growth and deliver environmental improvements - to level up across the UK. Co-ordinated effectively with plans in the devolved administrations, it should take a long term, strategic, integrating approach, engaging and empowering the leaders who will make it work. Our organisations stand ready to help with the development of the Framework, to make it as effective as possible.
